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Odie's Odd Odyssey Story

Odie is joined by crew mates, Eury and Amphi.

The Muses tell us about the 10 year Trojan War and Odie's wish to return home to Ithaca.

There is a storm so a safe island must be found.

Odie and the crew meet the Lotus Lovers who trick them to stay on their island forever.

They escape and meet the Cyclops who also traps them.

They manage to escape disguised as sheep.

Odie and the crew land on the island of Aeolia and take a rest.

Aeolus gives Odie a secret bag of winds to help them get home.

Someone opens the bag and the winds blow them back to Aeolia.

They continue their journey and land on Circe's island.

The witch Circe turns the crew into pigs, apart from Odie.

A parcel sent from the Goddess Athena arrives for Odie, which contains an unusual flowering herb.

Odie uses the herb's power to beat Circe and the crew is changed back.

As they continue their travels, Odie and the crew meet the sirens whose voices' lure sailors to their doom.

They manage to escape but then meet the multi-headed beast, Scylla.

Back at sea once again, Poseidon looks like he will spoil everything.

Athena saves them.

They meet Princess Nausicaa who helps Odie and the crew to find the true reason to return home.

They finally arrive back in Ithaca in time for the Games!

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
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To prepare for your multi-sensory and interactive film, it might be fun to gather together some bits and bobs to join in. Suggestions are given below but you can come up with your own alternatives. If several are suggested for a sensory moment or song, please do not feel you have to supply them all – one will do. And no need to fret, these items are not compulsory!



This sign will flash in the top left-hand corner of your screen as a reminder to pause the film if more time is needed to prepare the items.

Scene Order




The Prologue

Hankie or scarf and a ruler	Tie a hankie or small scarf to a ruler for the mast moment , or be as creative as you wish. Whenever you see Odie holding the ship's mast, grab your mast too!
Play parachute, or light weight material or sheet	A play parachute, light weight material or sheet for the storm moment to waft over heads.
W ater Sprayer	Why not use a water sprayer during the storm moment too, so the sea spray feels real for the crew? You could add a little salt for taste, but not so much that it will sting eyes!

The Land of the Lotus Lovers

Windmill, battery fan, real flowers or	Windmills (to blow on and spin), battery fan (for a gentle breeze), real flowers (for their scent) or a clock with moving hands to show how time is passing for the Cares Drift song . Remember to visit the <u>Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist</u> on our YouTube channel to see Erica demonstrating some of the dance moves!
Make-up for a beard	You could even draw a make-up beard on your face to show how time has passed, just like Amphi and Eury!



The Island of Aeolia

Soap, water, towel or fruit	Scented soap (to smell), bowl of water (for washing) and fluffy towel (for drying). Maybe an adult could serve little bits of a favourite fruit for the A Little Bit of Luxury song. You could even make yourself comfy on lots of soft and fluffy cushions!
Play parachute, or light weight material or sheet	The play parachute, light weight material or sheet again for the opening of the bag of winds moment.



Circe's Island

Water Sprayer	Why not use another water sprayer during Circe's magic moment to join in with the transformation spell into pigs? You could add a scent of some sort to make it smell interesting!
Piggy nose	Time to wear your piggy nose during the the Piggy Time song. Please visit the <u>Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist</u> on our YouTube channel to see Beatrice demonstrating how to make a piggy nose! The crafting items required can be found on page 14 of this resource pack. Remember to visit the <u>Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist</u> on our YouTube channel to see Erica demonstrating some of the piggy dance moves!

The Sirens

Fairy wings, cloak or wig	Wear a pair of fairy wings or a cloak, or maybe put on a wig for the turning into a siren moment.
	Sound like a siren as well as look like a siren! Please visit the Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist on our YouTube channel to find 3 sounds you can play to join in during the siren moment.

Scylla

Fish toys or Bucket or pot	Fish toys (to feel and move) or squidgy toys (to pull and stretch) scattered around the room for the collecting fish moment . You can get even use a bucket or pot to catch them in, like Eury and Amphi!
Glove puppet or sock	A glove puppet or use of a sock over hands like a glove puppet to become another head of Scylla during the Get Ahead When You Get a Head song.
Play parachute, or light weight material or sheet	The play parachute, light weight material or sheet again for the storm moment. Perhaps the salty water sprayer could come into use once more?

Home for the Games

Olive leaf crown	Time to wear your olive leaf crown during The Games song . Please visit the <u>Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist</u> on our YouTube channel to see Rachel demonstrating how to make the crown! The crafting items required can be found on page 15 of this resource pack. Remember to visit the <u>Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist</u> as well to see Erica demonstrating some of games dance moves!
Wind-up toys or beanbags and a bucket or pot	Wind-up toys, bean bags and a bucket, or maybe even an archery bow (but possibly no arrows!) to join in during The Games song .

Remember, as you're watching the film of *Odie's Odd Odyssey*, you can always press pause at any moment if more time is needed to set things up! And if you're particularly enjoying an interactive moment, you can always rewind and do it again!



Make yourself a piggy nose / 1

You might like to make a piggy snout to wear during the Piggy Time song. When Circe turns you into a pig, you will then have your own mini mask ready to wear! You will need ...

An egg carton



A marker pen, thin elastic, skewer and scissors

Some pink paint, or mixed red and white paint, and a paint brush





Scissors, glue and decorations

Craft paper or card to make a band long enough to fit around the head

Assisting Odie's friends

To help some participants access certain parts of the story, here are some techniques, with which you are sure to be familiar, that could be used:

Hand-over-hand

- A Little Bit of Luxury song to handle the soap and dip into the water bowl.
- The Games song to throw beanbags into buckets. You could even rig up your own bocciastyle game!

Touch

- Exploring moment in Cyclops cave feel some sticky, gooey cheese that might even have a great smell. (Doesn't have to be made from sheep milk!) Feel the softness of the woollen items, compared to the rough surface of the sticks or edges of the Jenga bricks.
- A Little Bit of Luxury song lathering scented soap, washing hands in the bowl of water and drying on a fluffy towel.
- **Piggy Time** perhaps mix up some soil and water? Might be fun to dip fingers into the goo for a muddy piggy rolling moment. (Keep the bowl of water handy to clean up afterwards!)

Buttons / iPads, etc

- **Responses** on page 17 program as required.
- Siren moment if you can't access the siren audio files on the <u>Odie's Odd Odyssey playlist</u> on our YouTube channel, maybe program some weird sounds or voices!

Sensation

- Nostos song wheelchairs could be moved around as the crew row the boat.
- Storm moments feel the flow of air from the movement of the parachute or material.
- Sprayers for all those wet moments!
- **Cares Drift song** feel the movement of air from the windmill or battery operated fan on faces, necks, hands or bare feet.
- Trying to escape past Cyclops wheelchairs could be moved from one side of the room to the other to match Odie and Eury's moves.
- Siren moment do you have any feathers with which to stroke faces, hands or tickle toes?
