A collection of Greek myths and stories, told from a sensory perspective, and accessible to all. Using chants, rhythms, puppetry, repetition and song, our professional actors will guide you through the three realms of the Greek world: the Underworld, the Earth and finally Mount Olympus. Allow us to draw you into Greek Mythology with tales of mischievous gods, brave humans and mythical creatures. Each story is brought to life using Makaton signing and singing. Fun, sensory props so everyone can fully participate in this 45 minute performance. Filled with delightful immersive moments for the whole family.

The Role...

Head2Head Sensory Theatre are looking for two performers to join our existing team of actors. We are looking for those who are engaging, friendly, humorous and good fun to be around. 'A Great Greek Adventure' has received Arts Council Funding, which has enabled us to provide work experience for three learning-disabled volunteer performers to work alongside us during an initial three public performance run. All of the actors (Volunteer and Head2Head) will be covering multiple roles each, either in character or puppeteering. We are ideally looking for those who have experience of working with children/young people with learning disabilities and puppeteering. If you do not have experience but are keen we would still like to hear from you. **However you do need to have a UK driving licence and be happy to drive our company van (Vauxhall Vivaro).**

In addition to performing, the roles will include singing (we usually include 4 to 5 songs in each of our shows) and the ability to Makaton sign (Head2Head will offer support and guidance if you haven't used it before). With Makaton, signs are used, with speech, in spoken word order. This helps provide extra clues about what someone is saying. Using signs can help people who have no speech or whose speech is unclear. Using symbols can help people who have limited speech and those who cannot or prefer not to sign.

Head2Head Sensory Theatre is committed to equal opportunities for all performers, irrespective of gender, age, race, disability, religion, sexual orientation, marital status or any other criteria not related to skills or abilities.

Rehearsal/Performance dates £166.50 per day. We do not offer any additional contribution for travel as the cast travel together in the company van from Oxted. If you choose to travel separately it is at your own personal cost.
